Gene Roddenberry's final space legacy entitled "Andromeda" has turned into a 26 episode series shooting in Vancouver, BC premiering October 2000. Lost Boys Studios, as lead animation & effects house, is part of the Vancouver crew working on the new series producing CG and digital effects including the soon-to-be-famed starship Andromeda, original fighter ships and several wonders of the universe including black holes.

The much anticipated starship Andromeda will have a never before seen design unique in shape as well as a propulsion system literally out of this world and never before seen on television. The Andromeda is made of sophisticated equipment but she is more than a ship; with personality and a conscience "Andy" is a character all her own whom sometimes is revealed in human form. At the helm of the ship is Kevin Sorbo, familiar to most as Hercules. Other crew-members include humans, aliens and androids visiting vast cultures and planets alike.

Allan Eastman with Fireworks Entertainment & Tribune Entertainment is acting as Executive Producer for the series as well as directing the premiere episodes. Eastman's series directing credits include RoboCop, Star Trek Voyager and The Outer Limits. The much-acclaimed Robert Hewitt Wolfe will be acting as Head Writer Supervisor for the series. Wolfe also wrote the premiere episodes and will be writing another 8 to 10 scripts for the season. Rumor has it that RUSH, a well-known 80's band might be creating the theme music...
