Set in Vancouver's high-tech Railtown, the new studio encompasses the 3rd floor of the Empire Stevedoring Heritage Building at 395 Railway Street in one of Vancouver's oldest cores.

The 5,600 square ft. facility is roughly three times the space of Lost Boys Studios' previous location. The added room will allow for Lost Boys to continue to expand the styles of animation it produces and broaden the type of production services it offers. In particular three new production spaces have been created

A **workshop** area dedicated to design modeling, airbrush painting and latex mold work.

A small **digital video shooting area** with an insert stage **blue screen wall**.

A theater-style digital media **screening room**.

The new studio location has completed its first set of renovations with a second phase to begin in January of 2001.
